

ACT 89 Auxiliary Reading Services

Auxiliary Reading services are funded through Pennsylvania ACT 89 and allocated by the Westmoreland County Intermediate Unit (IU). The IU contracts with Catapult Learning to provide a certified teacher to the school for auxiliary instruction time. Reading services may include, but are not limited to, reinforcement, skill practice, problem solving, or remediation. These services are coordinated with the classroom teacher based on the student's classroom performance.

Written parental consent is necessary for those students who are recommended by the classroom teacher or principal to be seen on a weekly basis throughout the school year. An initial assessment will be done to determine a student's skill level. Progress Assessment Reports will be distributed along with school report cards.

The Catapult Reading Teacher is available for conferences with parents and school faculty.
