

## **ART GRADES K-6 SCOPE and SEQUENCE**

All domains are taught and applied in each grade level. We build on each one and use previous knowledge for each specific grade. Basic elements and principles are of course taught at the beginning of each year and we use them consistently through- out the school year.

Below are the units of study for Grades K-6.

ELEMENTS of DESIGN- line, shape, color, texture, space

PRINCIPLES of DESIGN- balance, pattern, focus, contrast, unity

TECHNIQUES of DRAWING- basic drawing, shading, proportion

PAINTING- use of various brush strokes, mixed mediums

PRINTING- lettering rules, printing process, stamping

TWO and THREE DIMENSIONAL- use of form, shows depth and width

CERAMICS- use of various types of clay, plaster work for “masks”

CRAFTS- mixed materials( yarn, paint, foils etc.)

ART HISTORY- study of famous artists and their styles, incorporate into art projects

ART for the STAGE- basic set design, building and use of tools, drawing and painting on a larger scale

ART can be many things: abstract, still-life, portraits, landscapes, sculpture, collage etc.
