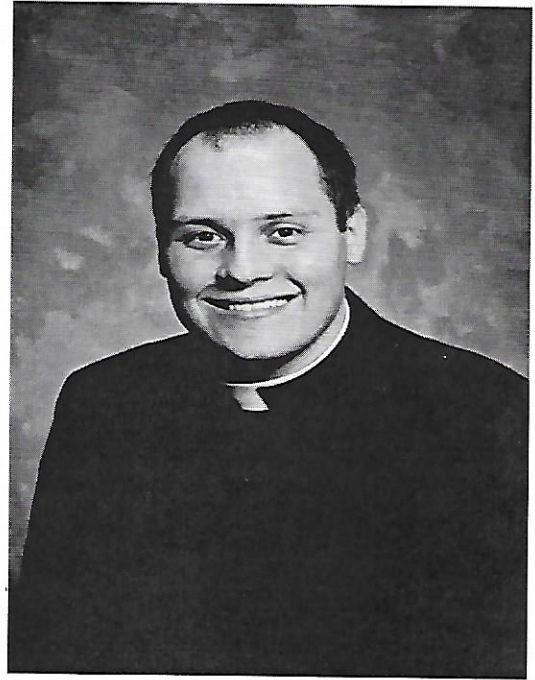


Welcome Our Special Guest
